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In response to recent videos showing beach goers bothering four manatees at Crash Boat beach in Aguadilla, Secretary of Puerto Rico's Natural and Environmental Resources Agency, Carmen Guerrero Pérez, has made an urgent call to Puerto Rico's citizenship to avoid disturbing marine species and notes that violators may be charged under federal and Puerto Rican laws that protect endangered species.
