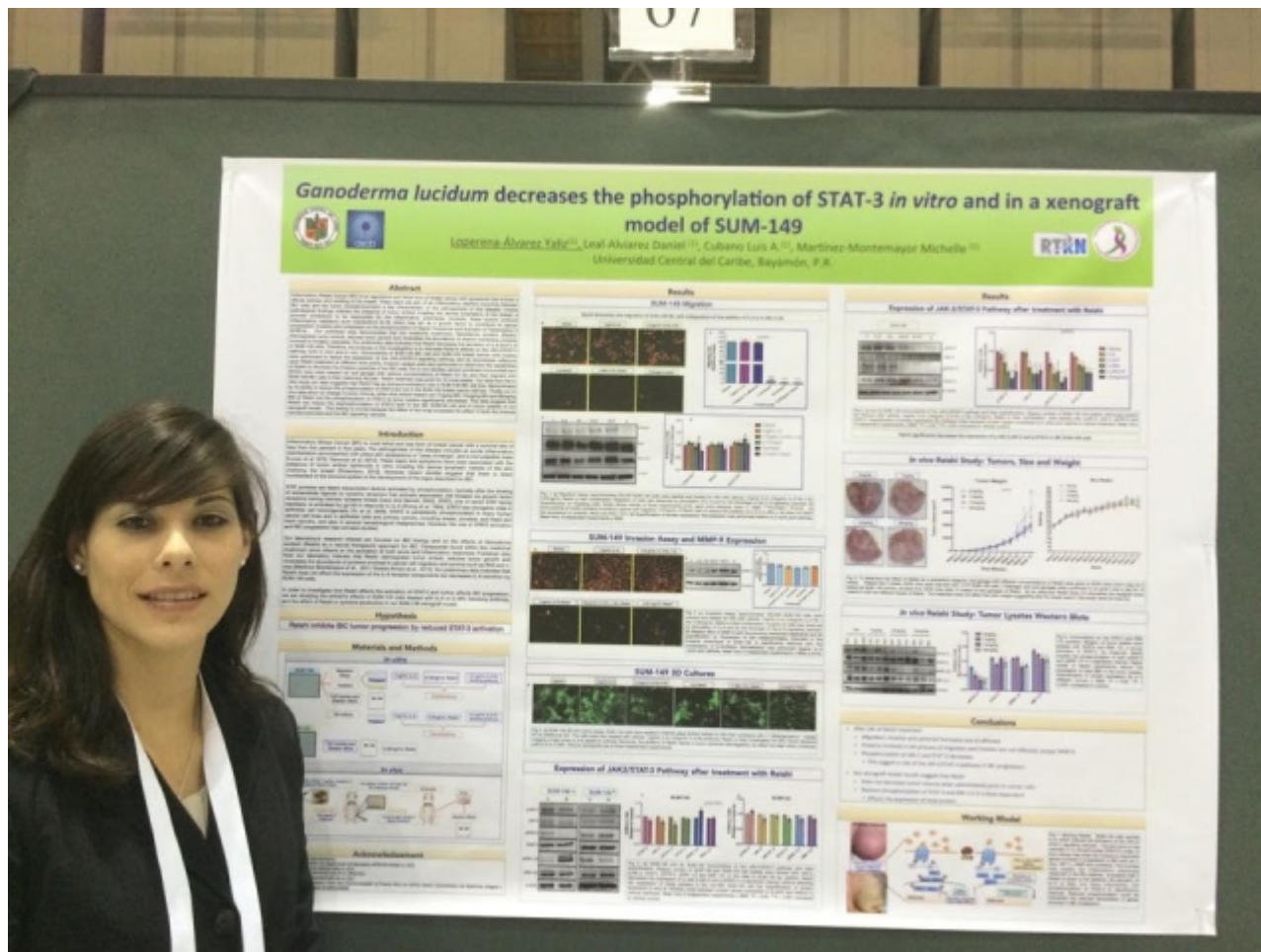


# Young Borinqueña wins poster competition at the annual American Society for Cell Biology meeting <sup>[1]</sup>
