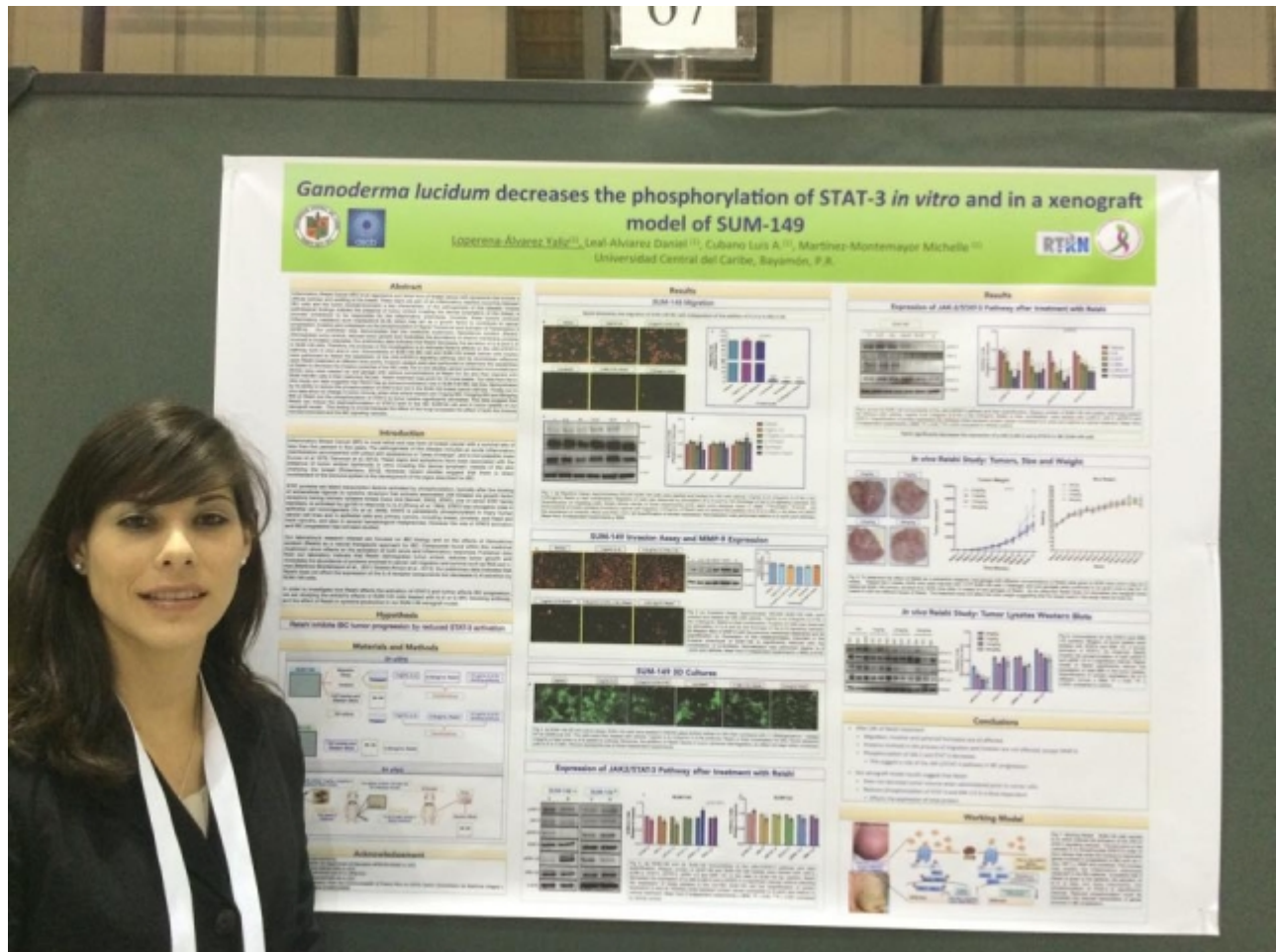


Young Borinqueña wins poster competition at the annual American Society for Cell Biology meeting ^[1]
