

Puerto Rican students win third place in national robotics competition ^[1]

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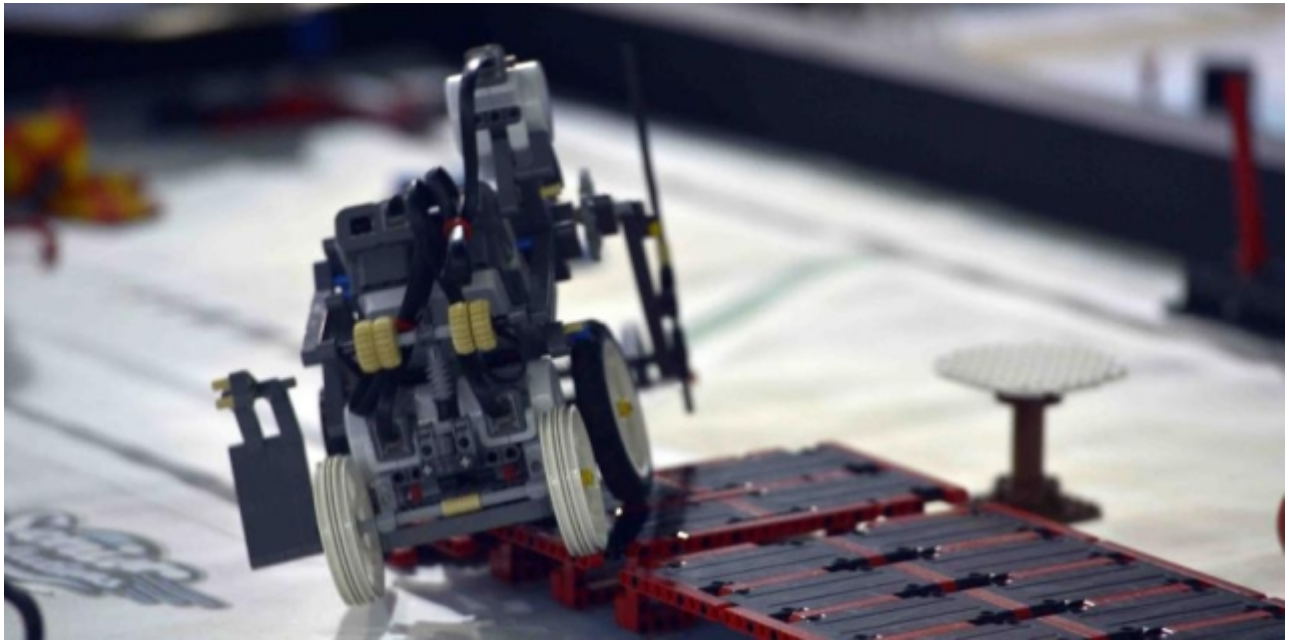
