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Students and faculty from the Department of Biology of the University of Puerto Rico Cayey published the results of their research in the prestigious scientific journal **Nature Microbiology** [3]. The research, led by professors Michael Rubin and Edwin Vázquez, describes a defense mechanism used by bacteria to avoid infection.
