Students in the 27 state and three private schools that receive the magazine will get information about diabetes and related research conducted in Puerto Rico, through interviews with to scientists and researchers. "With the allocation of \$1 million, other two magazines will be published. But MSC-UPR is seeking the collaboration of the private industry to publish other two editions. Each edition consists of 10.000 copies in English and Spanish, because the magazine is distributed outside the Island." "The next comic strips, that include guides for the teacher, will talk about AIDS, cancer and stroke. These are between the main causes of death of Latinos and Puerto Ricans" "In addition to the magazine, BREP has summer internship programs, professional development for teachers programs and community outreach programs."
