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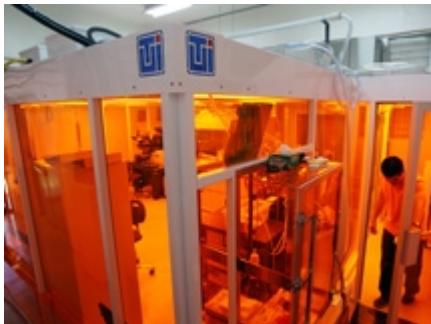

The UPR is at risk of losing millions of dollars in funding from federal agencies, valuable scientific and academic talent, and brain drain of talented students, as a result of its inability to

comply with the rules and norms of the National Science Foundation (NSF). In mid-March, the NSF will decide if it will suspend permanently all funding to the institution.
