"I feel very happy with this recognition, moreover because I am the first Puerto Rican and the first black woman receiving this distinction", commented the doctor, who has been directing the Section of Endocrinology of the Department of Medicine at the University of Puerto Rico's Medical Sciences Campus for four years and was president of the Puerto Rican Society of Endocrinology, from the 2001 to the 2003." "At the moment, Allende Vigo directs the International Committee of the Association, which has about 900 of the 5.000 members of the medical organization." This prize to "recognizes the dedication and compassionate care of health to patients with endocrine system diseases. It also distinguishes the demonstration of knowledge and experience in the field of the clinical endocrinology." Allende Vigo pointed out that this distinction also recognizes the School of Medicine of the University of Puerto Rico and to her fellow endocrinologists.

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
