### POSTER INSTRUCTIONS

Posters may have a maximum size of 42 inches tall and 48 inches wide. Posters smaller than this maximum size are acceptable. Posters must have the following parts: Title (sentence case), *author Name, coauthor Name, Affiliations, City and State* as in the Abstract; Introduction; Materials and Methods; Results; Discussion; Literature cited; Acknowledgments; For further information.

The poster presenters may hang their posters from **8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.** prior to the start of the Poster session, scheduled in the morning from **11:45 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** on Saturday, **October 28, 2017**. Poster presenters are expected to display their posters for the full time of the poster session and are required to be available for questions. Each poster will be evaluated by three judges. Presenters are expected to remove their posters after lunch, **1:00 pm**. Posters presentation award will be presented in the afternoon from **2:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.** Mounting materials for the posters will be provided by PRSM.

### ORAL PRESENTATION INSTRUCTIONS

The presenters will have until **October 25, 2017**, to send their Power Point presentation to [smpr50@gmail.com](mailto:smpr50@gmail.com), in order to have them set up in the presentation computer. The presenters should arrived to the facilities at **8:30 am** at least one hour ahead the Oral Presentation Section. The presenters will identify themselves at the registration table and will sit in the designated area near the stage. Oral presentations will last **15 minutes** of lectures and **5 minutes** for questions, **total time 20 minutes**.
