This is a **six week** training program to start on **June 10th**. Travel, lodging and a \$2,000 stipend will be provided to the selected students.

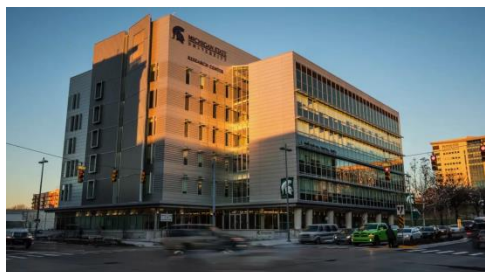
