ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Must be a U.S. citizen, national, or resident (DACA recipients eligible)
- Must possess an interest in exploring a career in the field of public health by the start of the program- ALL MAJORS WELCOME TO APPLY
- Be enrolled in a four-year institution and have completed at least two years of undergraduate education OR
- Community college graduates or transfers to four-year institutions OR
- Recent college graduates (Fall or Winter 2022 or Spring 2023) who have not enrolled in a graduate program by the start of the program
- There is no GPA requirement

**Additional criteria outlined in the application

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to be present in Los Angeles and participate in all program activities from June 18 - August 12, 2023
- Willingness to attend social and volunteer events on evenings and occasional weekends (virtually or in-person)
- Willingness to travel to the CDC in Atlanta, Georgia for a research poster showcase.
- Willingness to stay engaged with the program for alumni tracking, professional development opportunities, maintaining contact with the cohort, and participating in recruitment for the 2024 cohort.
