The University of Puerto Rico School of Pharmacy is one of six health professional schools at the Medical Sciences Campus located in metropolitan San Juan, Puerto Rico. The academic programs offered at the School include the Doctor of Pharmacy, a Graduate Program (Masters of Science in Pharmacy: Pharmaceutical Sciences and Industrial Pharmacy) a Pharmacy Practice Residency in Hospital Pharmacy, and a Community Pharmacy Residency. The Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences has an opening for a full time tenure-track ASSISTANT PROFESSOR or ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR in the area of Pharmacology/Toxicology. A Ph.D. degree, supplemented with postdoctoral research experience is required. Shared teaching responsibilities in both the Doctor of Pharmacy as well as the Graduate Program will be required. Candidates are expected to establish an independent externally funded research program that can integrate with current research interests in the Department. The Department of Pharmacy Practice has openings for full time tenure-track ASSISTANT PROFESSORS. Responsibilities include teaching, service, and research. Didactic and experiential teaching in the Doctor of Pharmacy Program is required. Doctor of Pharmacy degree and a Residency or equivalent clinical experience as well as a Masters are desired. Positions are available in the following areas of interest: Hospital Pharmacy Practice, Ambulatory Care Pharmacy Practice, and Pediatrics.
