The applicant must have a Ph.D., or an equivalent degree, in Immunology and Immunological Mechanisms, postdoctoral experience, and a research interest in Immunology demonstrated by publications in peer-review journals. The selected candidate will be required to establish and maintain a vigorous, externally-funded research program and participate in teaching of graduate and health sciences students: Medical, Dental, Pharmacy and Medical Technology. Ability to adapt and be productive in different cultural settings and knowledge of Spanish are definite assets.
