Abstract Submission Guidelines:

The topic for the First Conference in Applied Biotechnology POSTER and ORAL sessions is STEM CELLS RESEARCH.

Format:

All the authors are requested to submit electronically a one-page abstract with a maximum of 250 words in Times New Roman 11pt. The abstract should be single-column format double spaced, and justified at the both sides.

The Abstract submission should also include a Title (no capitals nor bold), the authors and Institutions in a format as follow:

The selected abstracts for poster and oral presentations will be notified by e-mail **Monday, September 1st, 2014.**

Poster instructions: There is no size requirement for the poster. Once receiving the acceptance notice, please notify to the Industrial Biotechnology Program office the size of your poster. The abstract should be placed on the left side upper corner of the poster.

Oral presenter: the chosen speakers will have 15 – 20 min seminar with 5 min Q&A (depending the number of speakers).
