The McGovern Institute is seeking postdoctoral fellowship applications from soon-to-be or recent PhD graduates in neuroscience, psychology, molecular and cell biology, biological engineering, or a related field. Come join our exciting research program in a vibrant city!

Our cross-disciplinary approach to understand the brain utilizes human imaging and cognitive neuroscience, computational neuroscience, materials science, neuroethology, genome engineering, and cell biology. Our researchers collaborate with academic, clinical and industry partners to explore the origins of disease, laying the foundation for the development and improvement of treatments for brain disorders including autism, schizophrenia, addiction, and Parkinson's disease.

This is a 2-year fellowship opportunity, with the possibility of extension. Starting Postdoctoral Fellows currently receive a stipend of \$58,608, based on the year 4 NIH rate, and are eligible for MIT benefits. MIT is a non-discriminatory/affirmative action equal opportunity employer.
