The Next Scholars Program of the New York Academy of Sciences, pairs **female mentors in STEM fields** with **first and second year undergraduate women** to work together one-on-one, over the course of one year, through **online** meetings and lesson modules. You'll expose your mentee to what a career in a STEM field is like, and help her develop the soft skills that are critical to future career success.

How the NEXT Scholars Program works:

- You'll be paired with a female first or second year undergrad majoring in STEM, who you'll meet with **one-on-one, online, twice a month, for a one-year time period.**
- Through the **NEXT Scholars Network** of mentors, you'll ensure that your mentee is exposed to a multitude of careers in STEM-related fields.
- Your mentee completes **online lesson modules** that develop soft skills, including: communicating effectively, critical thinking, and leadership.
