

2013 Robert I. Larus Poster Award

The Robert I. Larus Award is presented to a graduate student for his/her outstanding research. The winner is selected from among competing students presenting posters at the American Association for the Advancement of Science Caribbean Division 2013 Annual Conference that will be held on September 21, 2013 at the University of Puerto Rico, Medical Sciences Campus in the School of Health Professions.

Abstract deadline: September 6, 2013.

Guidelines: The text of the abstract should not exceed 250 words and the title is limited to 120 characters (including spaces), followed by the name of the presenting author, co-authors (including the research advisor), address and e-mail. The abstract must contain: (a) specific questions, hypotheses, and objectives, (b) methodologies, (c) results, and (d) conclusions. The poster should be $3' \times 5'$ or $3' \times 4'$ (width x height; portrait layout) and will be presented in English. The winner must be prepared to travel abroad to present the work at the AAAS Annual Meeting on February 13 - 17, 2014 in Chicago, IL.
