- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Enrolled in Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics (STEM) or DoD-relevant technical discipline

The program will take place at one of the many DoD facilities throughout the United States. Research assistants will work a 40-hour work week during the 10-week program.
